

Victims' leg up

SCOTS boffins are helping set up a "leg bank" to help landmine victims in Colombia.

The South American country has the highest landmine victim rate in the world and few have access to quality and affordable prosthetic limbs. A team at Strathclyde University has developed technology known as Majicast – secure prosthetic sockets aimed at victims on low income – in a project with Dutch social enterprise group ProPortion.
