

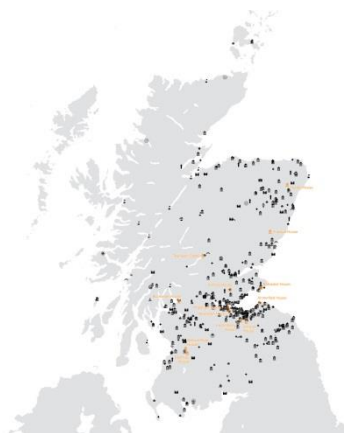
## NEW OPPORTUNITIES FOR THE MANAGEMENT OF SCOTLAND'S HISTORIC ENVIRONMENT
